Count circle: RED BANK / SUNNY CORNER (centered at intersection of Route 425 and Boom Road)

[All coverage was within a 24 km (15 mi.) diameter circle]

Count date: Dec. 19, 2015 (8:305 to 16:45 hours)

Sky & precipitation: 75% cloud cover at start and 50% at end; no precipitation all day.

Ground & water conditions: 80% snow cover (max. depth 15 cm) with 25% ice cover on Northwest and Little Southwest Miramichi Rivers,

brooks and ponds open. **Temp.:** -1° C to $+1^{\circ}$ C

Wind direction and speed: NW to W 5 - 20 km/hr

Total participants: 10 (5 field observers in 2 field parties, plus 5 persons at 4 feeders)

Total party-hours: 12.0 (0.25 on foot, 11.75 by car) **Total party-km:** 276.5 (0.5 on foot, 276 by car)

Instructions:

The mammal count can and should be done at the same time as the Xmas Bird Count in a circle 24 ms (15 mi) in diameter and should be conducted on one day between December 14th and January 5th.

Examples on how to fill out the sheet:

- 2, (T) 3 Snowshoe hare = this means that 2 snowshoe hares have been seen but also 3 different set of tracks during the count day.
- 4, (E) 1, (H) 1 Eastern coyote means that 4 coyotes were seen but also 1 excrement and one was heard.

Totals: 29 individuals of **4** species on count day plus 0 additional species during count period.
