- 2, (T) 3 Snowshoe Hare = this means that 2 snowshoe hares have been seen but also 3 different set of tracks during the count day.
- 4, (E) 1, (H) 1 Eastern coyote means that 4 coyotes were seen but also 1 excrement and one was heard. Please send all reports using one of the means at the bottom of page 2.

Totals: 66 individuals of 4 species on count day plus 3 additional species during count period.
