

# How to prevent birds from flying into your windows

Methods recommended by:

FLAP Canada

American Bird Conservancy

- Over 25 million birds fatally collide with windows in Canada every year.
- The average house without feeders kills approximately 8 birds per year (Heidi Trudell, Dead Birds for Science)
- What happens to birds that hit windows and survive?  
Sadly, the bird often dies, even when it is only temporarily stunned and manages to fly away. Many times these birds die later from internal bleeding or bruising, especially on the brain. (The Cornell Lab, All About Birds)

- Outside surface of window needs to be treated
- No more than 2" x 2" of glass exposed – protects smallest birds
- Feeders – place within 3 feet of window
